



WINTER 2016 WATERING GUIDELINES

Effective November 1 – March 31

Plano's watering schedule is based on the last digit of your service address. Addresses ending in zero are considered even. Irrigation systems operated by homeowner associations (HOAs) follow the even address schedule.

Maximum Once Per Week Watering Schedule

↓ LAST DIGIT OF ADDRESS

↓ WATERING DAY

1, 3, 5, 7, 9 (odd numbers)

Tuesdays

0, 2, 4, 6, 8 (even numbers)

Thursdays

- Turn off automatic sprinklers now that cooler weather has arrived. Most grasses go dormant until spring, which reduces your lawn's need for water. Subscribe to **WaterMyYard.org** for customized weekly watering recommendations.
- If watering is needed, set your sprinklers to run when the temperature is warmer, between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m., to avoid icing of streets and sidewalks.
- Planting cool season grasses, such as rye or fescue, is discouraged. These grasses require extra water during winter.
- Excessive water runoff and watering during rain, ice or snow is prohibited.
