
**WHEREAS**, the City Attorney has selected Victor A. Flores to be hired as an Assistant City Attorney III and is requesting the City Council's approval of same.

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-5-2

**An Ordinance of the City of Plano, Texas, transferring the sum of \$225,000 from the Convention & Tourism Fund Unappropriated fund balance to the Convention & Tourism Operating Appropriation for fiscal year 2017-18 for the purpose of providing funding for the USA Softball 18U and 16U Gold National Tournament, amending the Budget of the City adopted by Ordinance No. 2017-9-6, specifically Section 1, Item “H”, to reflect the actions taken herein; declaring this action to be a case of public necessity; and providing an effective date.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Plano approved and adopted the budget for the City for fiscal year 2017-18 setting the appropriations for the Convention & Tourism Fund at \$10,170,971; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Plano Parks & Recreation Department is requesting an additional appropriation in the total amount of \$225,000 to provide funding for the USA Softball 18U and 16U Gold National Tournament; and

**WHEREAS**, such costs cannot be fully met through appropriations in the existing budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council now finds that additional appropriations to the Convention & Tourism Fund to provide funding for the USA Softball 18U and 16U Gold National Tournament allows for the best utilization of the highest operating efficiency of the Parks & Recreation Department, and that such action is a public necessity.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION I.** The estimated sum of TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$225,000) is hereby transferred from the Convention & Tourism Unappropriated fund balance to the Convention & Tourism Operating Appropriation, as reflected in Section 1, Item “H” of the ordinance.


**SECTION II.** The budget of the City of Plano for fiscal year 2017-18 as adopted by Ordinance No. 2017-9-6 is amended to reflect the action taken herein.


**SECTION III.** The actions taken herein are found and declared to be a case of public necessity.

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-5-3

**An Ordinance of the City of Plano, Texas amending Section 12-73.1(d) of Article IV, Chapter 12, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Plano, Texas to enact school zones for summer school sessions; providing a penalty clause, a repealer clause, a severability clause, a savings clause, a publication clause, and an effective date.**

**WHEREAS**, both the Plano Independent School District (PISD) and the Frisco Independent School District (FISD) have schools within the City of Plano; and

**WHEREAS**, the PISD opens certain school campuses after the end of the regular school term for summer school sessions; and

**WHEREAS**, the school zones listed in Section 12-73.1(d) for summer school change from year to year as the schools used for summer school change from year to year; and

**WHEREAS**, an amended Section 12-73.1(d) is necessary to provide for a listing of the school zones and effective times applicable during the 2018 summer school sessions; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Plano finds it is necessary and in the best interest of the City and its citizens to enact school zones at and near schools open for summer school within the City of Plano; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council hereby finds that Section 12-73.1(d) should be amended.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS THAT:**

**Section I.** Section 12-73.1(d) of Article IV, Chapter 12, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Plano, Texas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“(d) *School zones designated.* The following designated locations and areas are declared to be school zones and the prima facie maximum speed limit for all motor vehicles operated within such locations and areas on school days shall be twenty (20) miles per hour during the designated time periods. Such school zones are designed to serve a public institution of elementary or secondary education.

*17th Street:*

- (1) Between Rigsbee Drive and a point two hundred (200) feet west of Rigsbee Drive on school days between 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. (6/4/2018 to 7/27/2018) (See also Janet Way)

- (1) Between Bristol Cove and a point two hundred (200) feet east of Dale Drive on school days between 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. (6/4/2018 to 7/27/2018)
- (2) Between a point two hundred (200) feet east of N Avenue and a point two hundred twenty-five (225) feet west of M Avenue on school days between 7:15 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. and between 11:45 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/28/2018)

*19th Street:*

- (1) Between a point six hundred fifty (650) feet east of K Avenue and a point one hundred fifty (150) feet east of N Avenue on school days between 7:15 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. and between 11:45 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/28/2018)

- (1) Between a point one hundred twenty (120) feet north of Yeary Road and a point one hundred twenty-five (125) feet south of New Haven Drive on school days between 7:15 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. and between 11:30 a.m. and 12:15 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/28/2018)

*Cross Bend Road:*

- (1) Between a point one hundred seventy-five (175) feet west of Country Place Drive and a point three hundred (300) feet east of Rainier Road on school days between 8:00 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. and between 2:55 p.m. and 3:40 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/29/2018)

*Emerson Drive:*

- (1) Between Preston Meadow Drive and Virginia Drive on school days between 8:00 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. and between 2:55 p.m. and 3:40 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/29/2018)

*Gifford Drive:*

- (1) Between Russell Creek Drive and Kalgan Circle on school days between 8:00 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. and between 12:15 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/28/2018)

- (1) Between a point two hundred seventy-five (275) feet west of Colchester Drive and a point one hundred (100) feet east of Jackson Drive on school days between 8:00 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. and between 2:55 p.m. and 3:40 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/29/2018)

*Jupiter Road:*

- (1) Between a point four hundred (400) feet south of Royal Oaks Drive and a point two hundred seventy-five (275) feet south of Park Boulevard on school days between 8:00 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. and between 12:15 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/28/2018)

*Laurel Lane:*

- (1) Between Jupiter Road and a point one hundred seventy-five (175) feet west of P Avenue on school days between 8:00 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. and between 12:15 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/28/2018)

*Lorimar Drive:*

- (1) Between a point one hundred twenty-five (125) feet west of Bramley Way and a point two hundred (200) feet west of Preston Meadow Drive on school days between 8:00 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. and between 2:55 p.m. and 3:40 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/29/2018)

- (1) Between a point three hundred (300) feet north of Mountview Place and a point three hundred twenty-five (325) feet south of Mountview Place on school days between 7:15 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. and between 11:30 a.m. and 12:15 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/28/2018)
- (2) Between a point two hundred fifty (250) feet north of Teakwood Lane and a point three hundred seventy-five (375) feet north of Russwood Lane on school days between 7:30 a.m. and 8:15 a.m. and between 10:45 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. (6/19/2018 to 7/19/2018)

*Russell Creek Drive:*

- (1) Between Gifford Drive and a point one hundred fifty (150) feet east of Pipestone Drive on school days between 8:00 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. and between 12:15 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/28/2018)

*San Gabriel Drive:*

- (1) Between Park Boulevard and a point fifty (50) feet south of Merriman Drive on school days between 8:00 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. and between 2:55 p.m. and 3:40 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/29/2018) (See also Los Robles Drive)

*Santa Fe Trail:*

- (1) Between Montana Trail and a point two hundred (200) feet north of Apple Valley Road on school days between 7:15 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. and between 11:45 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/28/2018)

*Spring Creek Parkway:*

- (1) For eastbound traffic, between a point four hundred (400) feet west of Eagle Pass and a point one hundred (100) feet east of Eagle Pass and for westbound traffic, between a point three hundred seventy-five (375) feet east of Eagle Pass and a point two hundred fifty (250) feet west of Eagle Pass on school days between 8:30 a.m. and 9:15 a.m. and between 12:45 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. (6/7/2018 to 6/28/2018)

*Willow Bend Drive:*

- (1) Between a point three hundred (300) feet south of Yearly Road and a point two hundred (200) feet north of Yearly Road on school days between 7:15 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. and between 11:30 a.m. and 12:15 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/28/2018)

*Yearly Road:*

- (1) Between a point one hundred seventy-five (175) feet west of Clark Parkway and a point two hundred twenty-five (225) feet east of Oakmeadow Drive on school days between 7:15 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. and between 11:30 a.m. and 12:15 p.m. (6/6/2018 to 6/28/2018)”

**Section II.** All provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Plano, codified or uncodified, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, and all other provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Plano, codified or uncodified, not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section III.** It is the intention of the City Council that this Ordinance, and every provision hereof, shall be considered severable, and the invalidity or unconstitutionality of any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other portion of this Ordinance.

**Section IV.** Any violation of any provision or term of this ordinance shall be a Class C Misdemeanor offense. Any person, firm, corporation, or association who is adjudged guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor offense under this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed TWO HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$200.00) for each offense. Each and every violation shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense.

**Section V.** The repeal of any ordinance or part of any ordinance affected by the enactment of this Ordinance shall not be construed as abandoning any action now pending under or by virtue of such Ordinance or as discontinuing, abating, modifying, or


altering any penalty accruing or to accrue, or as affecting any rights of the municipality under any section or provisions of any Ordinances at the time of passage of this Ordinance.
