Join us for the March screening of "What's On Your Plate?" at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, March 14. Studio Movie Grill in Plano, in partnership with the City of Plano's Live Green in Plano educational programs and services, shows a different family-friendly film each month during the Green Screen Film Series.

What's On Your Plate? is a witty and provocative documentary about kids and food-politics. Over the course of one year, the film follows two eleven-year-old African-American city kids as they explore their place in the food chain. Sadie and Safiyah talk to food activists, farmers, and storekeepers as they address questions regarding the origin of the food they eat, how it's cultivated, and how many miles it travels from farm to fork.
