## Sunset at Memorial Park Honors Those who Gave All from Plano

All gave some. Some gave all. It's a poignant truth about those who serve our nation's armed forces. On Monday, May 30, 2016 at 7:00 pm, Strengthening Families of North Texas, American Legion Harding-Blaine Post 321 and Casey Joyce All-America VFW Post 4380 present Sunset at Memorial Park will honor those men and women from Plano who died in World War I, World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War and the War on Terror in Somalia and Iraq.

**It will be held at Plano Veteran's Memorial Park located at 2101 Bay Hill Drive off Custer Road south of W. Spring Creek Parkway.**

Visuals include:

- Patriotic riders enter the park holding 43 flags, following the Bagpipe and drums.
- Wreaths laid by each branch of service representative while the bagpipes play "Amazing Grace"
- Roll Call – by DFW Blue Star Mother members. As each name is read, a match will be lit and dropped into the helmet by members of the American Legion and Billy Buck
- Gun Salute by the Plano Police Honor Guard
- Taps played
