

Second Human Case of West Nile in 2018 Reported in Plano

The Collin County Health Department notified the City about its second positive human case of the West Nile Virus in 2018. In addition, two of the City's mosquito traps have come back positive for the virus. The City will take proactive measures by spraying targeted locations in and around the areas of the case in addition to the two traps that tested positive. Weather permitting, Environmental Quality Division crews will spray Monday, September 24th, beginning at 9:00 P.M. Residents are urged to ensure children and pets are indoors during the time of spraying.

- Sutherland Lane (East)




Map 2 Spray Boundries:

Robinson Rd (East)




Map 3 Boundries:
