

## 3 Mosquito Pools Test Positive for West Nile

The City of Plano reports tests conducted of three pools of mosquitoes in City traps have come back positive for the West Nile virus. The locations include the 6200 block of Windhaven Parkway, the 2400 Block of Maverick Drive and the Oxbow Creek Lane/Kite Meadow Drive (Cottonwood Creek) area. The City will take proactive measures by spraying targeted locations in and around the areas of the traps. Weather permitting, Plano Environmental Quality Division crews will spray Thursday, October 11 beginning at 9:00 P.M. The targeted spray areas are bordered by the following:


### Area 1

- Royal Oaks Dr. (east)




**Area 2**

The City encourages citizens to follow common prevention practices:

DRAIN standing water in and around your home and neighborhood.

DRESS appropriately before going outdoors.

DEET (N, N-diethyl-m-toluamide) is an ingredient to look for when purchasing insect repellent. The use of bug spray is recommended at all times, when outdoors, especially during the day.
