The Plano Police Department will host their annual Peace Officer Memorial Service on Thursday, May 16, 2019, at 11:00 a.m. to honor Texas Peace Officers who made the ultimate sacrifice in service for their community.

The service will be held in the Florence Shapiro Council Chambers located at the Plano Municipal Center, 1520 K Avenue, Plano, TX. Twelve Texas Peace Officers who died in the line of duty will be remembered.

Participants in the service will include Chief of Police Gregory W. Rushin as well as officials from the City of Plano, Collin County, representatives from several area Police Honor Guards, and the Plano Firefighter Pipes and Drums.
