## **Suspicious Deaths**

On November 17, 2019 at approximately 10:21 p.m., the Plano Police Department was contacted by the McLennan County Sheriff's Office to perform a welfare check at a residence in the 2300 block of Pebble Vale Drive.

Upon arrival, Officers discovered a deceased male and female. Two females are currently in custody at the McLennan County Jail and are believed to be associated with the suspicious deaths.

This investigation remains on-going.
