Homicide Suspect Arrested

On November 16, 2019 at approximately 10:00 p.m., Plano Police Officers were dispatched to a weapons incident where someone reported hearing gunshots.

Responding Officers determined that shots had been fired into a residence in the 3200 block of Peachtree Lane after several individuals were kicked out of a party. A 16-year old male student from Allen High School was shot and taken to a hospital by Plano Fire-Rescue where he later died from his injuries.

Detectives identified and arrested 17-year old Kemond Smith, a resident of Forney, TX, on a warrant related to this incident. He has been charged with Murder and is currently being held in the Plano City Jail. A photo of Smith is attached to this release.

This investigation remains on-going.
