Plano Police Cancel Events

In an effort to contain the spread of the Coronavirus or COVID-19 within our community, the Plano Police Department has made the difficult decision to cancel some events and services until further notice. The safety of our general public remains our top priority.

- **Fingerprinting** services (normally conducted in our lobby) will be temporarily discontinued.
- The Department's **community rooms** will be closed to the public until further notice.
- **Citizens Police Academy** classes have been temporarily postponed. Attendees will be contacted when classes resume.
- The **Women in Law Enforcement** career event (scheduled for April 11, 2020) has been temporarily canceled.
- The **"Inspire Hope" Crime Victims Vigil** event (scheduled for April 20, 2020) has been temporarily canceled.
- The **National Drug Take Back** event initiative (scheduled for April 25, 2020) has been temporarily canceled.
- The **Plano Peace Officer Memorial Service** event (scheduled for May 14, 2020) will be held in a closed facility but will be live-streamed on Facebook and the Plano Television Network (Plano TV).
- The **Plano Police Recruit Civil Service Examination** (scheduled for May 30, 2020) will proceed. For details about the upcoming test, please visit www.planopolice.org.
