Collin County Health Services report 26 new COVID-19 cases, including nine new cases in Plano. The total number of Collin County cases is now 160 with 56 in Plano. Of those 160 County cases, 112 are active. Plano has 39 active cases. In the County 16 people are hospitalized. In Plano four people are hospitalized. There have been 805 negative tests in Collin County. 198 persons are under monitoring (PUM).
