Collin County Health Services report 26 new COVID-19 cases, including 12 new cases in Plano. The total number of Collin County cases is now 184 with 69 in Plano. Of those 160 County cases, 130 are active. Plano has 50 active cases. In the County 24 people are hospitalized. In Plano 11 people are hospitalized. There have been 814 negative tests in Collin County. 211 persons are under monitoring (PUM) in the County and 73 in Plano.
