Arrest Made Related to Crash

On Monday, May 11, 2020, Plano Police Officers were dispatched to a traffic crash at the intersection of McDermott Road and Preston Meadow Drive. Upon arrival, Officers observed a blue 2019 Ford F-250 and a white 2020 Honda Odyssey Minivan near the intersection.

The investigation determined the Ford F-250, occupied by only the driver, had been traveling north on Preston Meadow Drive and had run the stop sign striking the Honda Minivan that was occupied by three persons and had been traveling west on McDermott Rd. All those involved were transported to a local area hospital for medical treatment.

The driver of the Ford F-250 was identified as Jeffrey Alan Barnett of Allen, TX. Barnett was arrested and charged with three counts of Intoxication Assault, Unlawful Carrying Weapons, and Resisting Arrest/Search/Transport. An arrest photo of Barnett is attached to this release.

The three occupants of the Honda Odyssey suffered serious injuries, including a 3-year old child who was determined to have been unrestrained in the vehicle.

This investigation remains on-going by the Plano Police Department Traffic Unit.
