DSHS reports 31 new COVID-19 cases in Collin County, including 4 in Plano. The total number of positive cases in Collin County is 1,638, including 513 in Plano. The County has 313 active cases, including 105 in Plano.

There are four cases in the Denton County portion of Plano. All four are now recovered. With the Denton County cases, the total number of positive cases in Plano is 517.

Collin County had two duplicate positive cases yesterday, which decreased the total number of cases by two.
