PLANO POLICE OPEN NEW NORTHWEST SUBSTATION

Due to COVID-19 concerns, the Plano Police Department was unable to hold a traditional Open House for the new substation. As an alternative, we partnered with Plano TV to create a virtual Open House video for our community to see.

The new Northwest Substation is located at 4640 McDermott Road (corner of McDermott Road and Robinson Road) and will house various units of the department. There will be a total of 105 Plano Police personnel, sworn and civilian, working out of this facility.

This project was part of a 2017 Bond Election for public safety (Police and Fire). The building is 23,172 square feet and was built to improve services to a growing northwest section of Plano. This substation will also provide closer services to citizens for reporting crimes, obtaining copies of reports, as well as other police services. We want to thank the residents and businesses in Plano for their support and continued confidence in the Plano Police Department.
