Murder Arrests

On November 7, 2017, Plano Police Officers were dispatched to a Shooting incident in the 7900 block of Case Drive. Upon their arrival, they located a male inside his garage with a gunshot wound. It was determined the subject was deceased. The subject was identified as Christopher Collinvitti, a 58-year old who lived at the residence. The case was ruled a Murder.

After an extensive investigation by a Detective assigned to the Plano Police Department Crimes Against Person's Unit, three subjects were identified and have been arrested in connection with the Murder: Ladarus Demarquis Earl Keys, a 27-year old from Cedar Hill, Texas; Christopher Jamond Walker, a 28-year old from Arlington, Texas; and Jacob Anthony Malin, a 27-year old from Arlington, Texas. All three suspects have all been arrested and charged with Capital Murder. Keys is being held in the Collin County Detention Center; Walker at the Tarrant County Detention Center; and Malin at the Yazoo City Federal Correctional Institution in Mississippi.

Robbery was identified as a motive in the murder and the investigation remains ongoing.
