Fatality Crash

On Saturday, August 29, 2020 at approximately 9:30 p.m., Plano Police Officers responded to a traffic crash in the 3500 block of Custer Road.

Based on the investigation, a 2007 Chevrolet HHR, traveling northbound on Custer Road, turned westbound onto the 2100 block of Winterstone Drive. While the vehicle was turning, it was struck by a 2000 Suzuki motorcycle traveling southbound on Custer Road.

The driver of the motorcycle was transported to a local area hospital, but did not survive his injuries. Witnesses to the crash reported the motorcycle had been traveling at an extremely high rate of speed prior to the crash.

The driver of the motorcycle has been identified as William Earl Taylor, a 30-year old resident of Dallas. No other injuries were reported in the crash and speed is believed to be a factor.

The investigation remains ongoing by the Plano Police Traffic Unit.
