

DAYCARE/DAYCAMP POOL USE REGISTRATION

In order to use a City swimming pool for recreational swimming, all daycare centers or agencies (collectively referred to as “Agencies”) **must register and be approved prior to use.** (Agencies include non-licensed agencies or individuals who care for persons under the age of 16 and receive compensation for such service.)

1. Agencies must provide, at the pool facility, information sheets either digitally or printed, on the participants under their care. The following participant information is required:
 - Name and age
 - Address
 - Phone number
 - Emergency contact phone number
 - Parent/guardian consent to go swimming

This information is checked at the pool gate by the aquatic management team. City staff may also require the group to listen to a brief list of safety rules and may check participant’s swimming ability. It is the responsibility of the Daycare/Daycamp to provide or request lifejackets for non-competent swimmers or persons who are unable to perform drown proofing. If available, City will provide a lifejacket.

In the unlikely event of an emergency, Agencies **must** have current medical information available at the pool facility for each participant. At a minimum, this information should list allergies and other medical conditions which would be affected by emergency medical care.

2. Agencies must provide an adequate number of supervisors for the children under their care. This ratio is:

Age of Children	Staff: Number of Children
Under 7 years	1:3
7 and older	1:12

For children under the age of seven (7), the supervisors must accompany the children in the water at all times. Active supervision from the pool deck or in the water is required for ages seven (7) and older. For the purpose of this policy, staff/supervisors must be a minimum of sixteen (16) years of age.

I understand that the above items are necessary for pool use and that failure to comply with any of the above requirements may result in denial of pool use.
