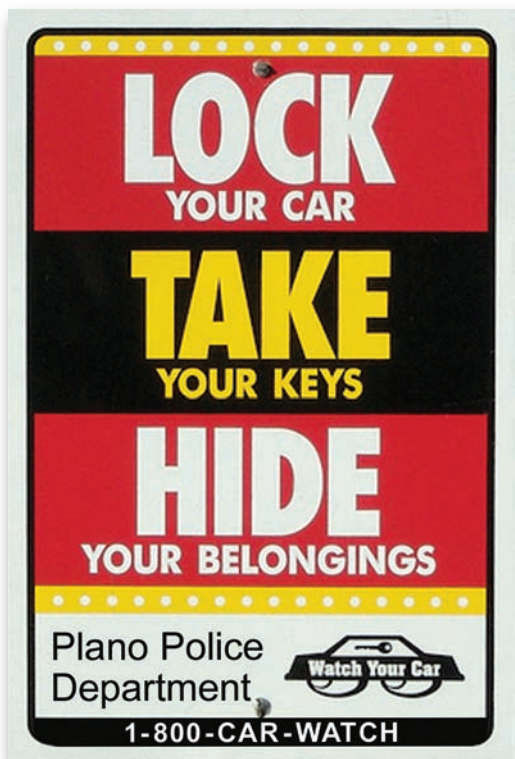

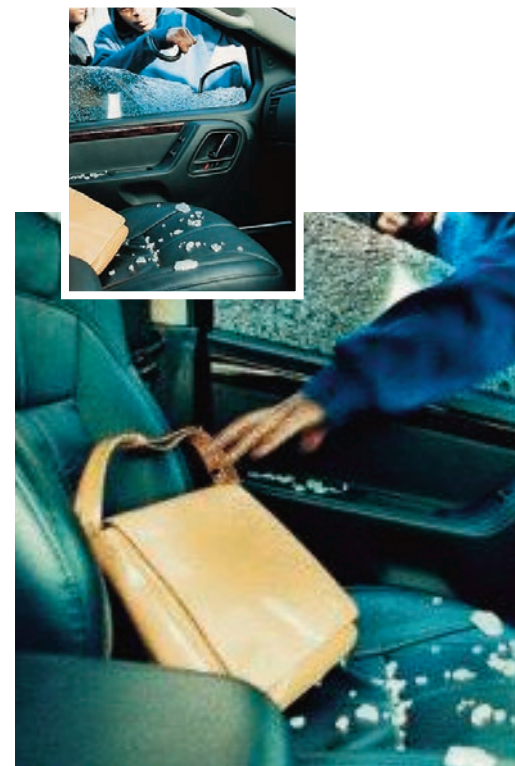


The Plano Police Department would like to thank you for participating in the **Lock Take** and **Hide** program and making a difference in your community. Remember **Lock Take** and **Hide** is a pro-active crime prevention program, aimed to prevent auto theft related offenses in your community.

While October is known as Crime Prevention month you should take measures to protect yourself every day of the year. Law Enforcement agencies are requesting that all apartment communities, hotel/motels, business shopping centers and office buildings participate in this pro-active crime prevention program. Management companies send a message to their residents and patrons that they care enough to remind them to **Lock** their cars, **Take** their keys and **Hide** their belongings.

Residents are asked to do their part in reducing the number of offenses by locking their cars, taking the keys and hiding or removing visible items from inside their vehicles. Items such as cash, change, CD's, credit cards, hand bags, wallets, checkbooks, dry cleaning, golf clubs, laptop computers, brief cases, Ipods, cell phones, tools and shopping bags are an invitation for thieves. If you want to keep it, take the steps to protect it. If you observe any suspicious activity in parking lots report it to the police immediately by calling 911.

Don't be a victim do your part and protect your valuables by taking them out of your vehicle.
