What Are The Requirements?

- Students must be in 8th through 12th grade.
- Students must maintain passing grades in all classes in order to participate which complies with No Pass-No Play.
- Attendance is required. If it is necessary to miss a day, students are advised to contact their School Liaison Officer. Generally, no more than two absences will be excused. Excessive absences will result in dismissal from the Academy.
- Students will comply with the PISD Dress Code. Students are reminded of the professional environment in which they will attend classes and should dress accordingly.
- Students must comply with all of the rules of the Plano-Richardson Police Training Center and conduct themselves in a business like manner at all times.
- Students must complete a Consent and Release form and have it signed by a parent or guardian in order to participate.
