

## **Small Group Classes offered at Plano Public Library**

### **Blog Builder**

Ages: 14-16

Grades: 9-10

Maximum Number: 12

Learn about the history of blogs, different types, and the basic components of a blog post. Participants will create their own WordPress blog and write a book review as their first post.

### **Digital Movie Maker**

Ages: 11-14

Grades: 6-8

Maximum Number: 10

Learn about film techniques and how cameras are used to create dramatic effects that leave an impact on the audience. Participants will record their own short film using various angles. Then, they will edit their footage by compiling the shots and enhancing them with visual effects and background music.

### **Digital Photography**

Ages: 16-18

Grades: 11-12

Maximum Number: 12

Learn about different types of cameras, angles, the three-quarters rule, and other photography tricks. Participants can use library-provided iPads or personal devices to take pictures, which will then be edited and arranged into a collage using Photoshop Express.

### **Library Tour**

Ages: 5+

Grades: K+

Maximum Number: 12

Learn about library resources, programs and behind the scenes processes through a tour at one of our locations.

### **Robotics: How Robots Move**

Ages: 5-7

Grades: K-1

Maximum Number: 12

Learn about what robots are and how they work. Participants will get hands-on experience programming Bee-Bots and Code-a-Pillars.

### **Robotics: Programming Robots**

Ages: 8-11

Grades: 2-5

Maximum Number: 12

Learn about what robots are and how they work. Participants will get hands-on experience building and programming their own robot using provided LEGO WeDo kits.

## **Storytime**

Ages: 3-6 with parent/caregiver

Maximum Number: 25

Learn early literacy skills such as letter sounds, vocabulary and narrative skills through a storytime with age-appropriate books, flannel stories, rhymes, puppets and storytelling.
