Transported Patients were received at 15 area hospitals in January.

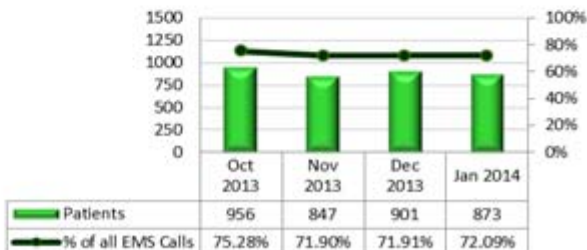

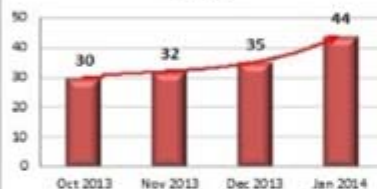

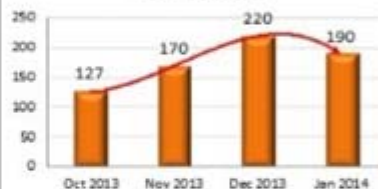

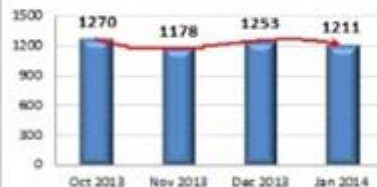

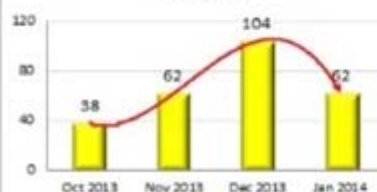

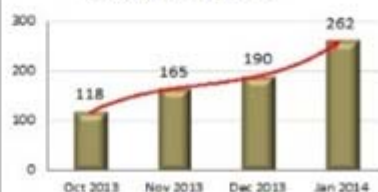

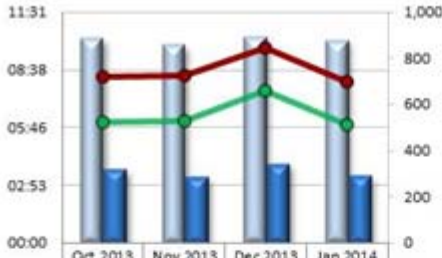

Travel and Total Response Times both normalized after the December spike, likely due to the ice storm, but did not come down to Oct/Nov levels

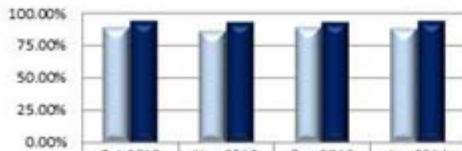
Compliance with the Benchmark and Best Practice targets returned to Oct/Nov levels following the December spike.

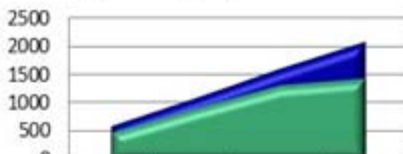

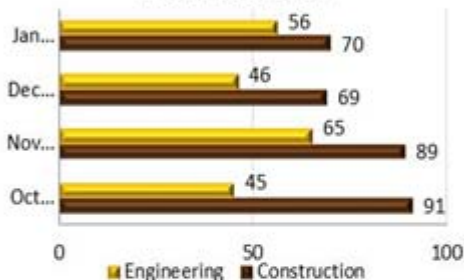
